- **Old Business**
 - Budget Approval We are expecting everything to get approved, which is great!
 - Park Updates Our maintenance department and the King William Little League are working together to get things done at the park. Troy states that stuff has been ordered for the lights.
- **Manager Reports**
 - After School – Numbers continue to grow. Up to 85 kids. Next year registration will open June 1st.
 - Spring Soccer – games have started, and everything is going well. Food Truck will be coming for the rest of the soccer season's games from Another Round or two.
 - Blastball- Registration is open and we have 6 kids registered so far.
 - Summer Sneakers -Waiting to find out which location we will be using. Once they see which schools are having construction, then they will decide on where we can have Summer Sneakers. We have about 75 kids registered already These numbers came in without sending flyers to the school yet.
 - Fall Soccer – Registration opens June 6th.
- **Strategic Planning**
 - Survey Results- Results show that majority would like to see growth in the courthouse area for Parks and Recreation. Results show that additional parking is needed most at the park. Evelyn said opening night was very congested and she couldn't get out for 45 minutes. Kayla said another exit would help. Evelyn said

the top parking lot is a waste since people park all the place and block each other in. Results show that fields would be mostly needed. (Soccer, Football, multi-purpose) Stewart asked what time does Football practice. Corey responded M-F 6-8, until schools starts and then they switch the time from 6:30-8p.m. Veda asked do we have other land that we could build fields on. Mr. Ashcraft states that he wants to present to the board to get the Hill company to come in and do a Recreation expansion plan. They would also be looking at HHMS to do some expansion for fields and a new playground. They would also look at the property around the courthouse as well to see if there was a possibility for fields on that property. They will do a review of River front property as well for expansion and other opportunities for the community to enjoy. Waterfront development also had 3 votes, which was the same as the fields. Results show for the grant question that purchasing land with grant money would be number one. Veda shared about how parks are so important for health and that they have a Rural Health Plan in place in some localities. Veda shared that Charles City received a Get Outdoors Grant. They used it for walking trails and a pier for fishing along with a boat landing.
