Public Hearings on the Proposed FY '23 Budget, Proposed 2022 Tax Levies, and Proposed Utility Fee increases were held on Monday, April 11th, at the Board of Supervisor's Work Session meeting.

The Proposed Tax Levies and Utility Fee Increases are up for approval by the Board of Supervisors at their Monday, April 25th, Regular Meeting.

The Proposed Budget Approval and Appropriation are up for approval by the Board of Supervisors at their Monday, May 9th, Work Session.



### HIGH MILEAGE DISCOUNT DEADLINE MAY 1ST

If your vehicle has a high amount of mileage, you may apply for a reduction in your personal property tax assessment. Download and complete an [Application for High Mileage Discount Form](#) (PDF), one per vehicle, and attach supporting documentation, such as inspection certification or oil change receipt. All applications are due to the Commissioner of the Revenue's office by May 1st. No adjustments will be made after this date.
