


Regional Animal Shelter

- Fines for littering in Virginia range from \$500-\$2,500
- 52% of roadway litter comes from motorists
- \$11.5 billion is spent on litter pickup operations in the United States each year
- VDOT spends approximately \$3.5 million annually in taxpayer dollars on litter cleanup
- 50% of littered items are cigarette butts
