One of the best ways to get involved in local government is to attend public meetings. Many meetings are recorded and posted to the [County's YouTube Channel](#). Board of Supervisors, Planning Commission, Economic Development Authority, and Board of Zoning Appeals meetings are normally recorded. Meeting agendas are normally posted to the County Website (click on the "[Agendas & Minutes](#)" button) at least three days in advance of the meeting date. You can also read minutes of past meetings. Minutes are normally posted about one month after the meeting once they have been approved by the Board or Commission.
