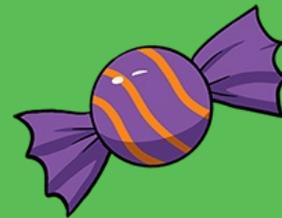
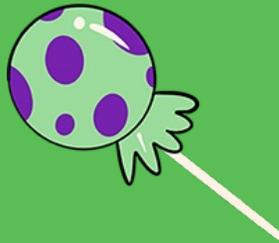




Have a Safe & Fun Halloween!
