Broadband News ...

The **Breezeline** expansion mainly focuses on the northeast section of King William County. Those already served in areas by Breezeline, mainly the Central Garage area and 360 corridor, may want to take advantage of the [Affordable Connectivity Program](#) and the [Line Extension Customer Assistance Program](#) (LECAP).

All Points Broadband is working with the County to provide fiber-to-the-home service to all parts of the county not already slated for broadband through other grant projects. Make sure you [register your address on their website](#). This information will help them ensure universal coverage and finalize their construction sequence. **All Points will be giving a project update at the November 7th Board of Supervisors Work Session.**
