

The Virginia Department of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS) is pleased to announce the Civilian Response and Casualty Care (CRCC) course. This training, designed and built on the **Avoid, Deny, Defend / Run, Hide, Fight** strategy, provides strategies, guidance, and a proven plan for surviving an active shooter event. This course combines the civilian response with the **Stop the Bleed Campaign**, which empowers civilians to provide life-saving medical aid before first responders arrive. Topics include the history and prevalence of active shooter events, civilian response options, and basic medical intervention to reduce preventable causes of death.

Board of Supervisors Reduces Personal Property Tax Rate

On Monday, August 22, 2022, the King William County Board of Supervisors approved a reduction in personal property tax rates on four specific categories of vehicles. Combined County and School Division tax rates on motorcycles, vans, cars, and trucks were reduced by one dollar, from \$3.65/\$100 to \$2.65/\$100 for King William citizens living outside the town of West Point. West Point residents will be taxed by the County at a rate of \$1.195/\$100, a reduction of \$0.455, which is the Countywide portion of the combined tax rate. [Read more ...](#)
