Back-to-School Vaccine Checklist

August is National Immunization Awareness Month (NIAM).

Before returning to school, students should receive the following vaccines:

Starting School - Ages 4-6

- Diphtheria, tetanus & pertussis (DTaP)
- Polio
- Chickenpox
- Measles, mumps & rubella
- Flu

Elementary School - Ages 7-10

- Flu

Middle School - Ages 11-13

- Tetanus, diphtheria, & pertussis (Tdap)
- Human papillomavirus (HPV)
- Meningococcal
- Flu

High School - Ages 14-18

- Meningococcal
- Flu
