COUNTY COVID STATS

- King William County is averaging nine cases per the most recent seven-day average as of Dec. 15.
 - King William County residents have experienced 2,252 cases of COVID-19 since February, 2020 as of December 15, 2021. A total of 74 required hospitalization and 26 passed away.
 - County Government continues to follow a mask policy when dealing with the public and non-vaccinated personnel.
