



The [Virginia Department of Housing and Community Development](#) launched a statewide [Digital Opportunity Survey](#) to provide data to supplement the development of the Virginia Digital Opportunity Plan.

The survey aims to understand where respondents reside within the Commonwealth and their

- Current levels of broadband access;
- The affordability of the broadband services; and
- Their level of comfort navigating the internet and digital devices.

All Virginians are encouraged to take the survey.

The Virginia Digital Opportunity Plan will enable the Commonwealth to apply for federal broadband funding from the Digital Equity Act Capacity Grant program. These funds will be used to support efforts to address the affordability of internet services, increase digital literacy programming and resources aimed at increasing digital adoption, and launch unique programs that address the digital divide.
