The American Red Cross will be holding a blood drive at the Parks and Recreation Community Center on Thursday July 13 from 10am – 3pm. If you don't do it for the free snacks, here are a few fun facts to let you know how your donation makes a difference in our community:

- Each donation of 1 pint can save up to 3 lives
- About 1 in 7 people entering a hospital need blood
- Children being treated for cancer, premature infants and children having heart surgery need blood donations
- If all blood donors gave three times a year, blood shortages would be a rare event (most donors give twice a year)

Get your creative juices flowing - more information and submission instructions will be coming soon.


