

Rabies Clinic Saturday November 4, 2023



For Dogs & Cats at the King William County Courthouse
Pets from surrounding counties welcome!
8:30 a.m. - 11:30 a.m.

NO APPOINTMENT NECESSARY \$10 per Rabies Vaccine - CASH ONLY!

IF YOU WOULD LIKE YOUR PET TO RECEIVE A 3 YEAR RABIES VACCINE, YOU MUST BRING A RABIES CERTIFICATE THAT SHOWS YOUR PET HAS BEEN VACCINATED BEFORE—EVEN IF IT'S EXPIRED! FIRST COME FIRST SERVE BASIS.

When you arrive, please stay in your vehicle until you are assisted.

For the safety of your pet, dogs must be on a leash and cats must be in a pet carrier.

Article 3.2-6521 of the Code of Virginia requires owners of dogs and cats 4 months or older to have the animal currently vaccinated against rabies by a licensed veterinarian.

Article 3.2-6531 requires all dog owners and custodians to securely fasten the Dog License tag to a collar to be worn by the dog.
